July 22 | 5:30 p.m. | Oacoma

- From Arby's in Oacoma, drive 7.5 miles north on 339th Ave
- Turn right on 340th Ave and follow the road for 5 miles
- Turn right on Ft. Hale Rd and go 1.7 miles to arrive at the pasture

August 12 | 5:30 p.m. | Mitchell

- Meet 0.5 miles east of intersection 419th Ave and 268th St
- 2 miles north and 9.5 miles east of Dimock

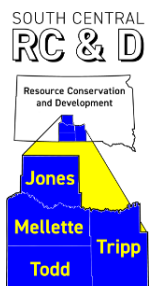
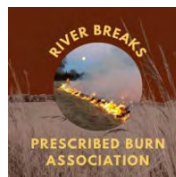
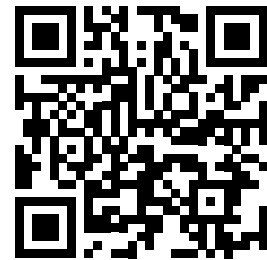
August 27 | 5:30 p.m. | Yankton

- From the intersection of Hwy 81 and Hwy 46, go 1.5 miles south to NE Jim River Rd
- Turn west and go 0.8 miles to arrive at the Knutson residence on the south side of the road

September 17 | 5:30 p.m. | Oacoma

- From Arby's in Oacoma, travel west 1 mile on Hwy 16
- Turn left and travel south 3.5 miles down Cooper School Rd/ Co Rd 6
- At the fork in the road, stay left and keep traveling 3 miles south down 337th Ave
- Turn right and travel 0.5 miles west on 252nd St.
- Parking will be on the south side of the road
